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2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		During the academic year 2021-22, online teaching was the primary mode of instruction from the commencement of the semester in September till the end of November 2021. The 'Digital Learning Preparedness' survey was carried out among students of all programmes during the beginning of the academic year. Based on the analysis of the student survey, which revealed that most students were better equipped to learn through the online mode, the institution continued to deliver lectures and share learning resources through online platforms such as 'Zoom', 'Google Meet', 'Microsoft Teams', 'WhatsApp' and 'Google Classroom'. Intra Semester Assessment (ISA) was carried out through the online platform- 'TestMoz', subscribed to by the institution. The institution provided all members of the teaching faculty with an institutional web domain ID for an unlimited storage space through the Google platform, which was necessary for imparting knowledge and sharing learning resources with students, in addition to storage of reference material, class assignments, educational videos, slide-show presentations with voice-over, as well as other such related material. For subjects requiring physical interaction and for enhanced student learning; in-person classroom interaction was scheduled in small student batches, ensuring social distancing and efficient management of COVID-19 protocol. This began with practical oriented subjects such as Accounting, Costing, Mathematics and Statistics. Further, students were also permitted to carry-out reference work and prepare student material through scheduled personal visits to the college library. For IT-related content delivery and practicals, sessions were carried out in the computer laboratories. Wherever necessary, extra and remedial sessions were also carried out in the online or in-person mode. Supplementary reading material was shared with students through PPTs with voice-overs independently created by the teaching faculty, as well as student reference to the micro e-modules contributed by the teaching faculty in both 'English' as well as 'Konkani' languages for the 'Digital Integrated System for Holistic Teaching And Virtual Orientation (DISHTAVO)' portal- an initiative of the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Goa.
