

CIRCULAR

In accordance with the Special Ordinance OS-1, the UGC Revised Guidelines on Examination and Academic Calendar for the Universities in view of COVID-19 pandemic and the earlier circulars issued relating to <u>UG Programmes of General Education</u> for the current academic year 2020-21 to the extent applicable.

Guidelines for the conduct of the First and Second year (B.A./ B.Sc (including Home Science)/
B.Com/ B.C.A/ BBA/BBA(FS)/ BSW Programmes) for repeat/regular & old/new course students

- The Examinations for UG programmes on the University Campus shall commence from 21st June onwards. The Examinations for UG programmes in the Affiliated Colleges shall commence from 9th July onwards.
- 2. Examination for the First/Second year shall be conducted in online mode only.
 - a) The duration of the examination shall be two hours for 30/40 marks respectively. In the case of examinations of 120 marks the paper shall be set for 40 marks and scaled up to 120 marks.
 - b) There shall be only one Question Paper per subject per college.
 - c) The question papers shall be sent to the students through any of the following platforms: Google Classroom, Moodle, E-mail, Whatsapp etc. at 10:00 a.m.
 - d) Students may either type the answers electronically or write down the answers and then scan/photograph and upload the answer sheet. Students will be required to upload their answer scripts latest by 1:00 p.m.
 - e) The college shall retain soft-copies of the uploaded answer papers for record.



The pattern of the question paper and formula for declaration of the results of specific programmes shall be as follows:

- The examination will be of 30/40 marks if the SEE component is of 60/80 marks for the First and Second year.
- ii) There will be only two questions for these exams.
 - a) Question No. 1 shall have 8 questions of 2 marks each, out of which the students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b) Question No. 2 shall have 6/8 questions of 5 marks each, out of which the students will answer any 4/6 questions.
 - c) The marks obtained by the student in the SEE shall be doubled.

[NOTE: Subjects such as Accounts, Costing, Maths, Statistics may have questions of 10 marks each of which students will answer <u>ANY FOUR</u>]

B) B.B.A Programme:

For the purpose of calculating the trimester result, 50% of the marks shall be from the CIA component of each paper and the Semester End Examination shall be for 50% of the marks.

C) BBA (Financial Services) Programme:

For the purpose of calculating the result the existing 40 marks for ISA for each paper will be scaled upto 50 marks and the Semester End Examination shall be 50 marks.





- ii. There shall be only one Question Paper per subject per college.
- iii. The question papers shall be sent to the students through any of the following platforms: Google Classroom, Moodle, E-mail, Whatsapp etc. at a)10:00 a.m and/or b) 2:00 p.m.
- iv. Students have to write down the answers and then scan/photograph and upload the answer sheet. Students will be required to upload their answer scripts latest by a)1:00 p.m or b)5:00 p.m respectively.
- v. The college shall retain the soft copy of the uploaded answer papers for record.

The pattern of the question paper and formula for declaration of the results of specific programmes shall be as follows:

A) B.A.B.Ed/ B.Sc.B.Ed Programmes:

- Examination with Theory component only shall be of 30/35 marks. There shall be two types of short answer questions.
 - a) Question No. 1 shall have 8 questions of 2 marks each out of which the students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b) Question No. 2 shall have 6/7 questions of 5 marks each, out of which the students will answer any 4/5 questions.
 - c) The marks obtained by the student in the SEE shall be doubled.



vii. The practical component examination also shall be held in online mode.

B) B.Ed Programme

- i) Examination with Theory component only shall be of 30 marks. There shall be three questions.
 - a) Question No. 1 shall have 2 questions of 10 marks each, out of which the students will answer any one question.
 - b) Question No. 2 shall have 2 questions of 10 marks each, out of which the students will answer any one question
 - c) Question No. 3 shall have 2 parts of 2 questions each of 5 marks out of which the students will answer any one question in each part.
- ii) For declaration of the results the following formula shall be used:

50% of the marks of the previous year + 20% marks of the Projects and Assignments + 30% marks of the Year End Assessment.

B) B.P.Ed Programme:

- i) The theory component examination shall be of 30 marks.
- ii) There will be two types of short answer questions.
 - a) Question No. 1 shall have 8 questions of 2 marks each out of which the students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b) Question No. 2 shall have 6 questions of 5 marks each, out of which the students will answer any 4 questions.
- iii) For declaration of the results for the theory paper the following formula shall be used: 45% of the marks of the previous semester + 25% marks of the ISA + 30% marks of the SEA
- iv) The practical examination will be in online mode for semester IV of 300 marks (250 marks for lesson plan and 50 marks for still test).
