




Activities	Tentative Dates

## REPORT

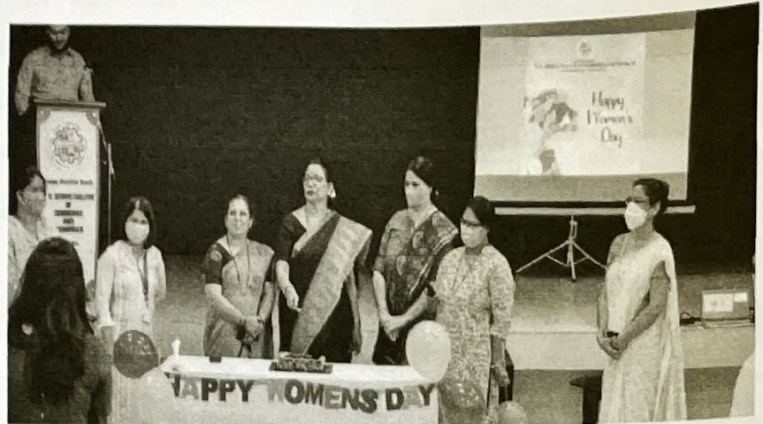
### International Women's Day Celebration

Venue: College Auditorium


The entire fraternity of S.S. Dempo College got together on the 8th of March 2021 to celebrate the International Women's Day with great enthusiasm.



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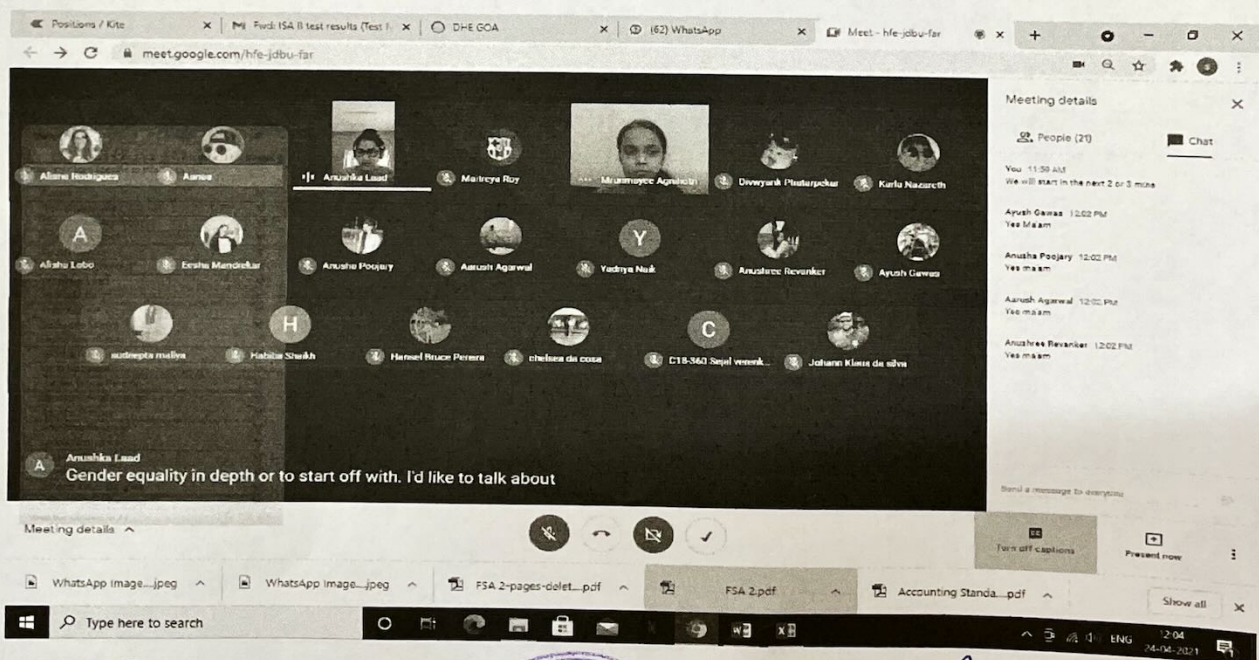
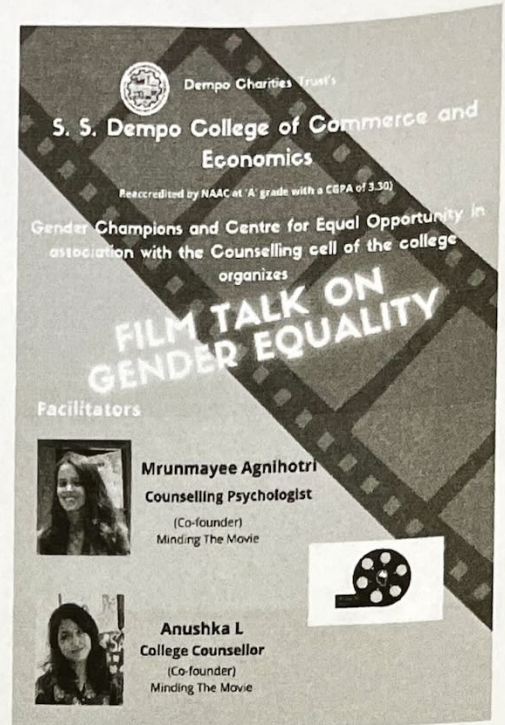
**REPORT**

Mode: Online (Portal -Google Meet)


The Gender Champions Cell and the Centre for Equal Opportunity Cell in association with the counselling cell of the college, organized "Film Talk on Gender Equality" through an online Google Meet platform. The session was organised with the aim of using movie as a medium to initiate a healthy and participative discussion on the topic of gender equality and related issues. The session was facilitated by Ms. Anushka Laad, College Counsellor and the co-founder of Minding the Movie and Ms Mrunmayee Agnihotri, a practicing Counselling Psychologist at Institute for Psychological Health Thane.

Around 20 students across different sections of BCom, BBA and MTTM were advised to watch the movie 'RBG' prior to the day of discussion. To support the agenda behind talk, students were instructed to note down key takeaways whilst their viewing of the movie. The interactive session continued for an hour. The session commenced with facilitators and students sharing their insights about the movie followed by a discussion on understanding Gender, Gender roles, how gender stereotypes affect gender equality. The session also highlighted the significant impact Gender inequality has on mental health of individuals. 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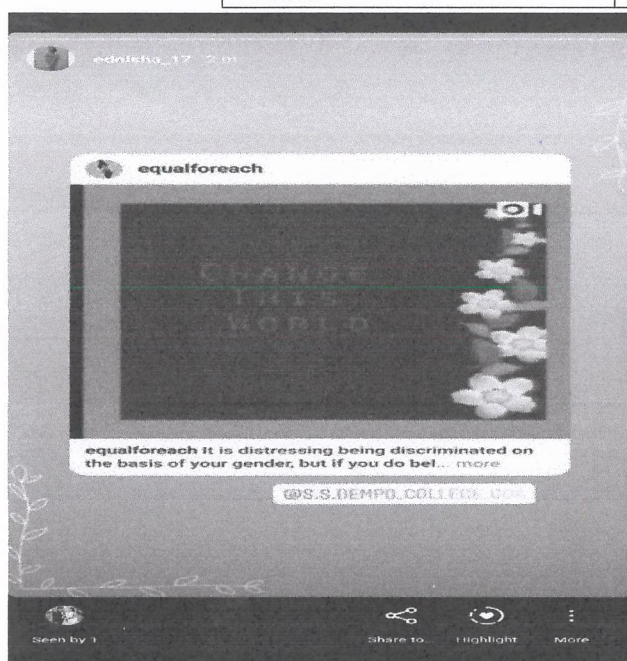
