7. No other monetary or non-monetary obligations are involved between either of the parties to the arrangement of this Memorandum of Understanding.


8. Consideration for EVENT PARTNERS

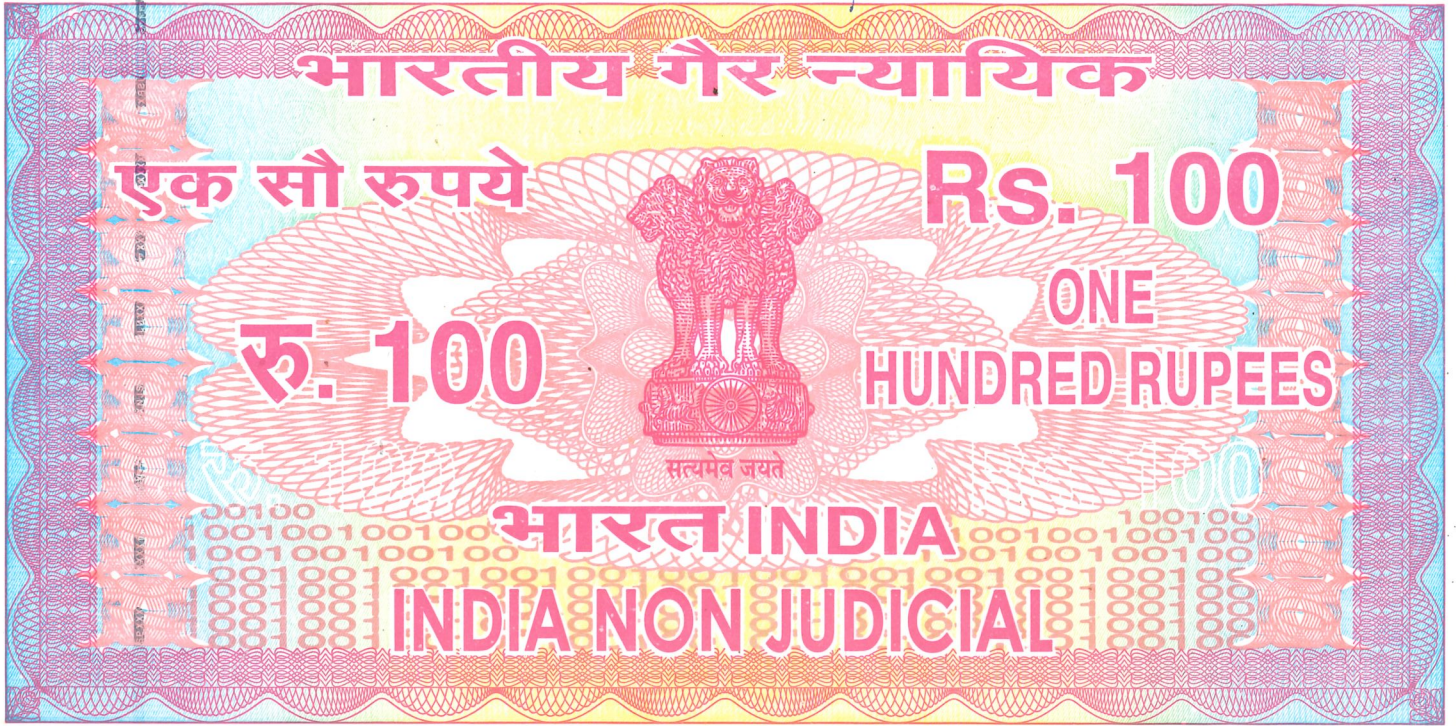

## **A. The Parties**

**Goa Management Association**, formed in 1975, affiliated to the All-India Management Association (AIMA), New Delhi and having its address at OS-10, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Facility Block, Sapana Gardens, CHOGM Road, Alto Porvorim, Goa – 403521 (Hereinafter referred to as ‘GMA’)

S.S. Dempo College of Commerce & Economics, a College established in 1966, affiliated to Goa University, accredited by NAAC at A grade, and recognized under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 and having its address at Deendayal Integrated School Complex, Cujira, Goa – 403202 (Hereinafter referred to as ‘Dempo College’)

‘GMA’ and ‘Dempo College’ shall collectively be referred to as ‘Parties’ and individually as ‘First Party’ and ‘Second Party’ respectively.

## **WHEREAS:**

1. GMA is an active and vibrant Local Management Association of AIMA, set up to represent the interests of Management practitioners, professionals and students in Goa and to promote and develop education and research in the discipline of Management
2. Dempo College is a premier Higher Education Institution in the State of Goa, imparting education and carrying out research in the disciplines of Commerce, Economics and Management.

GMA and Dempo College agree to establish a programme for cooperation in areas of mutual interest and in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this MoU.

## **B. Objectives**

1. To foster collaboration between the Parties on areas of common interest and concern
2. To bridge the Industry-Academia divide
3. To provide the First Party with avenues to share the expertise of its members or invited resource persons with faculty and student members of the Second Party
4. To provide opportunities to the faculty and students of the Second Party to gain practical exposure, so as to strengthen the knowledge and skill base of faculty members and enhance the learning experience of students
5. To facilitate the advancement of knowledge through academic and research collaborations.

## **C. Terms of Reference:**

1. The First Party, as part of its efforts to promote education and research in the Management discipline, will explore ways and means of involving students of the Second Party in its

2. The Second Party, as part of its efforts to bridge the perceived Industry-Academia divide, will work with the First Party to improve students' learning and readiness for work.

#### **D. Responsibilities:**

##### **The First Party will**


- a) invite the students and faculty members of the Second Party to attend programs that it organizes on its own, or on behalf of AIMA
- b) provide students of the Second Party opportunities to participate as volunteers for such programmes, which will help them meet and network with industry stalwarts from Goa as well as from all over the country
- c) involve the faculty members and students of the Second Party in any research project that it might undertake
- d) provide resource persons / speakers from amongst its members for workshops / conferences / seminars / webinars organized by the Second Party
- e) encourage its members to provide internships and on-the-job training opportunities to students of the Second Party
- f) encourage its members to participate in the Placement Fair and any other placement activity organized by the Second Party
- g) upon request from the Second Party, identify from among its members, possible Guest Faculty based upon their areas of expertise, and encourage these members to participate as Guest Faculty

##### **The Second Party will**

- a) encourage its students to participate in programs organized by the First Party
- b) provide the First Party and/or its members, student support wherever needed, for minor data collection.
- c) collaborate with the First Party in research activities, wherever there is scope for such collaboration.

#### **E. Coordination**

The Parties shall each appoint a Coordinator who will have the responsibility of, implementing the MoU, carrying out periodic reviews, and finding ways to strengthen the collaboration between the two Parties.






## F. Terms and Termination

1. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two Parties. It will remain valid for a period of five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement.
2. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date. Once terminated, neither Party will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other Party may suffer. However, both Parties will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
3. Any cooperation under this MoU is subject to the availability of funding sources.
4. In the event that either Party wishes to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulting from the implementation of this MoU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent from the other Party.
5. Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation between the Parties.
6. This MoU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MoU.

## G. General

1. This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each party.
2. The Parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MoU. Non-disclosure agreements will be made for each such event between the individuals involved from both institutions.
3. This MoU is signed subject to approval by respective academic / administrative bodies.


