WORKSHOPS CONDUCTED BY DEPARTMENT OF I.T.

(2017 TO 2022)

08th Nov 2017: One-day workshop titled "**Uniformity in Teaching Patterns for Computer Applications**" was organised for all the Commerce College Lecturers. Seventeen Colleges participated for the same.

In view of the change of syllabus under CBCS the need for a workshop was expressed by Department of IT to bring uniformity in teaching patterns for the revised syllabus.

Although time and again this concern was raised by all the teaching fraternity we realized no such workshop was conducted even till the end of Semester-I. Thus Department of IT conducted the workshop "Uniform Teaching Pattern for Computer Applications" under CBCS, just before the closing of Semester-I.

Teachers from 15 Commerce Colleges participated in the deliberation and there were 17 participants from all over Goa.

The agenda included the following:

- 1.) Evaluation of Semester-I
- 2.) Discussion about Semester-II of Computer Applications Paper

The coordinator and Head of Department Sangeeta Chakrabarty welcomed the participants.

Each member introduced themselves and shared the experiences with regards to teaching of topics in Semester-I

It was noted that different colleges have adapted different marking pattern distribution of Marks for two ISA's, practical, Q paper subsections.

Discussion took place for attendance and certificate issued to the students.

Resource Person-I: Dr. Harip Khanapuri from S. S. Dempo College of Commerce and Economics gave presentation/demo on Financial Statement through spreadsheet. These are needed for a successful business plan. Also determines whether an organization's long term investments such as new machinery, replacement of machinery, new plants, new products, and research development projects are worth the funding of cash through the firm's capitalization structure. He covered topics like Capital Budgeting, Ratio Analysis, Depreciation, Loan, Loan and Repayment Schedule.

Resource Person-II: Mrs. Sharmila Kunde from V.V.M's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics spoke about the conduct of ISA and marks weightage of the same.

After debating and deliberations all the participants concluded that ISA marks distribution pattern in two ISA's may be adapted suiting to the individual college.

In the post lunch session, discussion took place on the topic: How to conduct practical for semester-II.

The following divisions for practical were discussed:

- I. LAB-I Demonstration
- II. LAB-II Review of online sites. Using online Services and comparing two sites for same product
- III. LAB-II Case Study of Cyber Crimes and Mapping a given list of cyber crimes
- IV. LAB-II Demonstration, enact cyber crime through movie maker

Mr. Shekhar from Government College spoke on the Web Application for Smartphone data collection, app for Geo Tagging and its usage by NSS volunteers for the community service, which can be used extensively. EpiCollect.net provides a web and mobile app for the generation of forms (questionnaires) and freely hosted project websites for data collection. Data are collected (including GPS and media) using multiple phones and all data can be viewed centrally (using Google Maps / tables / charts)

The workshop ended with thanking all the participants for their contribution and discussion. This report was sent to concerned University officials at BOS- UG (Computer Science Dept.)
